### **Bid for MOACON 2026: There will be online election for this**

1. Only affiliated District chapters can bid for the conference.
2. The Bidding chapter should be registered under Registration of Society's Act 1860, is affiliated to MOA & have a PAN No. / GIR No. / Tan No / GST number with Income Tax Department
3. All the interested affiliated District Chapters should go through the Requirements of the Venue given in the Constitution and prepare their bid in that format, accordingly.
4. The Venue should be any one of the Following Cities, irrespective of the Bidding Chapter:  
Ch. Sambhajinagar, Goa, Kolhapur, Mumbai, Nagpur, Nashik, Navi Mumbai, Pune
5. Bids prepared in the standard Proforma & sent to Hon. Secretary, before 8<sup>th</sup> January 2024
6. These Bids will be scrutinized by MOA Office, and then names of eligible District Chapter and Venue will be given to the Election Officer.

### **Eligibility Criteria for individual Posts**

#### **B) President Elect, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer**

1. He should be life member of the association for at least 10 consecutive years. He should not be convicted for criminal charges before any Competent Court, Authority and or

Medical Council of India and State Medical Council. If there is medical profession related reason for criminal charges, he can take prior permission and approval from Executive Committee to contest the Election. It is the Executive Committee, who will decide and define whether the charges are of criminal nature or not.

2. He should have completed 3 years as Elected EC member of MOA at the time of applying for the post, and or at the time of assuming the office.

## C) Executive Committee Member

1. He should be life member of the association for at least 5 consecutive years. He should not be convicted for criminal charges before any Competent Court, Authority and or National Medical Council and State Medical Council. If there is medical profession related reason for criminal charges, he can take prior permission and approval from Executive Committee to contest the Election.

## D) Joint Vice President:

1. To bring small districts into main stream and to have representation in Executive Committee, there will be 4 Joint Vice President, who will be exclusively residing and having official residential address from following Districts. One Joint Vice President will be elected from each region, viz. **Vidarbha, Marathwada, Konkan and Rest of Maharashtra.**
2. The District having 75 or more members will not be eligible for this category. Only those Regions having 4 or more districts, having less than 75 members will be eligible for this representation. Voters for these posts will be only from that particular Zone.
3. The eligibility Criteria will be same as for Executive Committee member.
4. The tenure of this Joint Vice President will be of 1 year.
  - a. **Vidarbha:** Akola, Amravati, Bhandara, Buldhana, Chandrapur, Gadchiroli, Gondia, Wardha, Washim, and Yavatmal
  - b. **Marathwada:** Beed, Hingoli, Jalna, Latur, Nanded, Osmanabad, Parbhani.
  - c. **Konkan:** Palghar, Raigad, Ratnagiri, Sindhudurg, Thane
  - d. **Rest of Maharashtra (North & Western):** Dhule, Nandurbar, Satara

If an elected person resigns from his post without any justifiable cause, explained to Executive Committee and if not accepted by Executive Committee, he will not be eligible to contest any post for next 5 years, from such resignation.

4. Last date of withdrawal: 15<sup>th</sup> January @05:00pm
5. Declaration of Initial List of Eligible Applicants: 15<sup>th</sup> January @06:00pm
6. Last date of filing grievance by the applicants: 20<sup>th</sup> January @0600pm
7. Redressal of Grievances: 21<sup>st</sup> January to 30<sup>th</sup> January
8. Declaration of final list of Eligible Contestants: 5<sup>th</sup> February @0600pm
9. Online voting 21<sup>st</sup> February @1100am to 28<sup>th</sup> February@ 1100am
10. Results to be declared on 28<sup>th</sup> February@ 1200 Noon
